

# Lansbrook Pool Rules

1. Lifeguards are in charge at all times and have the authority to refuse admittance. Maximum bathing Load: 121 Swimmers.
2. When warranted, the pool will be closed. Efforts will be made to schedule special events and pool parties so as not to conflict with daily pool operations.
3. One long whistle blast means all swimmers clear the water immediately.
4. When only one Lifeguard is "On-Duty", a 10 minute safety break will be held during the last part of each hour. During the safety break, swimmers 18 year old or over may swim at their own risk. Swimmers under 18 must exit the pool.
5. Swimmers or occupants who violate the rules are subject to 10-45 minutes of restricted admittance. If problems persist, the swimmers or occupant will be asked to leave immediately and/or permanently. The swimmer or occupant will not be allowed admittance until the HOA, and/or Pool Director have reviewed the offense. Other rules may be added to protect the health and safety of swimmers, occupants, Lifeguards, Laborers, or the pool and its infrastructure.
6. Be prepared to present ID verifying residency of Lansbrook. Those residents delinquent in their dues will be denied entrance.
7. All residents must sign in before entering the pool. Please sign your name, address, emergency contact number and number of guests (if any), and age of any minors.
8. A guest charge is determined annually and payable upon entering. Four guests per family will be allowed per day. A resident must accompany their guests at all times.
9. No swimmer or occupant under the age of 12 will be allowed at the pool or pool area without a parent or attendant 16 years of age or older.
10. Lifeguards may require proof of ability to swim. Common sense and rules of courtesy will prevail.
11. All swimmers or occupants who are in diapers must wear a leak proof swim diaper. Any "accident" that occur in the pool water will require immediate pool closure.
12. All Divers are subject to a Lifeguard approval before performance. Only one diver on a diving board at a time, only one bounce on the diving board per dive and no diving into water under 6 feet deep.
13. THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED inside the pool area: Alcohol, Foul Language, Glass, Horseplay, Nudity, Profanity, Running, Smoking, Use of any flotation device without prior approval of Lifeguard and Swimmers or Occupants with infections, seeping wounds or skin disorders.
14. The Association is not responsible for swimmers or occupant's accidents or injuries or damage to, loss of or theft of personal property.
